Not to have completed a BE 90 or BRC HT 90 or above in the current competition year at close of prelim entry. Horses may be registered with BE but must not have any BE points. Not to have completed a BE 90 or above in the current or previous calendar year.

#### Riders

Not to have completed a BE 90 or BRC HT 90 or above in the current competition year at close of prelim entry. May not compete at 90 or above in the same Qualifier or Championship.

**Horses** – not to have gained 0 BE points. Horses may be registered with BE but must not have any BE points. Not to have completed a BE 100 or above in the current or previous calendar year.

**Riders** who have competed under FEI Rules in the last 5 calendar years. Eventing restrictions at HT80, HT90 applies to 2\* and above only and for HT100 and CH100 applies to 3\* and above only.

**Riders** who have competed under FEI Rules eventing in the last 5 calendar years. Eventing restrictions at HT80, HT90 applies to 2\* and above.

#### CLASS 4 • Mixed 100cm

This is a mixed class open to senior and junior teams and individuals, teams may be any combination of seniors and/or juniors, the best three scores to count.

Horses - No Limit

Riders who have competed under FEI Rules eventing in the last 5 calendar years.

#### **Open/Non-Qualifier Teams**

**NEW for 2024:** Non-qualifier teams consisting of 3 or 4 riders across any classes (sections B,E,H & J) teams may be any combination of seniors and juniors for both riding club members and open unaffiliated riders, the best three scores to count.

All Open NQ Teams must be declared to the secretary by Saturday 1st June 6pm.

#### **Refunds and Cancellations**

In the event of adverse weather conditions causing the postponement of the event all entries will stand. If the alternative date is not suitable you have seven days to withdraw in writing to the entry's secretary via email. Withdraws after the closing date will only be refunded if replaced off the waitlist, less 15% admin fee.

#### **Area 12 RC Members**

All team managers are asked to provide via email to the entry's secretary their intended teams at close of entries. (Please not the change of rules for NQ teams as above). Riders must state their Riding Club and if riding as part of a team or individual qualifying or non-qualifying. If this information is not supplied, then the entry will be entered as an open individual and may prevent your club from fielding a full team. Any changes will incur a strict admin fee of £5 after times are published.

#### Important for all competitors

- All persons attend the event at their own risk. Area 12 Riding Clubs or the landowner or his employees accept no liability for damage, injury or loss to horses, riders, spectators, or personal property whilst on the showground.
- This event is run under British Riding Club Rules, which are available on the British Riding Clubs website. We draw your attention to the rules about hats which must have the 'Pink' tags and back protectors 2018.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry.
- All competitors must bring their own number bib and numbers
- Objections must be made within 20 minutes of posting the results, accompanied by a fee of £20, which will be re-funded if the objection is upheld.
- All dogs on leads at all times no exceptions. Instant £20 fine.

Junior 90 - Two-Day - Day 1: Dressage & show jumping. Day 2: Cross-country

Senior 90 - Two-Day - Day 1: Vet Inspection, Dressage and Cross-country Day 2: Show jumping.

Mixed 100 - Two-Day - Day 1: Vet Inspection, Dressage and Cross-country Day 2: Show jumping.
