All horses attending this competition must have a correct flu vaccination history as per BRC rules. See section G7 of the BRC hand book.

Horse and rider eligibility is taken from the close of pre-entry. Members must be showing on the BRC database the last working day before the competition date.

Senior and Junior Novice Dressage Eligibility:

BD Intro 3 (2024) - Up to 35 BD points at Prelim, 0 BD points at Novice or above. Not to be a BHS Stage 4 Coach or above.

BD Prelim 1 (2024) Unlimited Prelim points, up to 35 BD points at Novice, 0 BD points at Elementary or above. Not to have competed at Elementary BD/BRC or BE Novice or above in the 12 months before close of pre-entry. Not to be a BHS Stage 4 Coach or above. Not to have competed at Elementary BD/BRC or BE Novice or above in the 12 months before close of pre-entry.

BD Prelim 2 (2024) Unlimited Prelim points, up to 35 BD points at Novice, 0 BD points at Elementary or above. Not to have competed at Elementary BD/BRC or BE Novice or above in the 12 months before close of pre-entry. Not to be a BHS Stage 4 Coach or above. Not to have competed at Elementary BD/BRC or BE Novice or above in the 12 months before close of pre-entry.

BD Novice 1 (2024) Unlimited Novice points Up to 35 BD points at Elementary 0 BD points at Medium or above Not to be a BHS Stage 4 Coach or above. Not to have competed at Medium BD/BRC or BE Intermediate or above in the 12 months before close of pre-entry.

Rules and Conditions of Entry:

1. Please bring your horse/ponies passport; spot checks maybe carried out.
2. Riders must bring their own bridle numbers/saddle cloth numbers, and the competitor numbers should be displayed on both sides of the horse/pony.
3. There will be no scoreboards at the event. Results will be posted on www.ridingclubresults.co.uk
4. Number of riders will be limited in the warm up, on entry to the warm up arena please report to the dressage and tack stewards.
5. Owners and riders enter at their own risk.
6. The judge's decision in relation to the competition results and that of the official steward in relation to all other matters will be final.
8. Dressage tests at Area Qualifiers may be commanded.
9. In the event of withdrawals, the organisers regret that they cannot refund entry fees after the close of prelim entries.

10. Balloting may take place if excessive entries. Qualifying team entries will be prioritised.

11. All horses and ponies must be 4 years or older.

12. Please do not skip lorries/trailers out onto the car park – please pick up all droppings and clear up any hay/haylage. No horses/ponies to be left tied up outside to trailers or lorries unattended.

13. Competitors must wear the correct hats, dress and footwear. Please refer to the BRC rule book 2024. Hats must have a valid BRC official hat tag (pink).

14. Health and Safety – The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards.

15. Legal Liability: Horse/pony sports can be dangerous and animals are unpredictable. Neither the Warman family, Kings Sedgemoor Equestrian, Lamberts Castle Riding Club Ltd or any person acting on their behalf, or the landowners can accept any liability for the loss, damage, accident or injury to any person or property. It is a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the above persons against any legal action arising from such an incident.

Please note veterinary cover is not in attendance for this competition, but The Stables Equine Practice will be on call. (Payment for any treatment given needs to be made to the vets on the day).

Sharman First Aiders will be in attendance at the event.
