Surfaces

These qualifiers will be run on the All Weather arenas. Please note that the Lincoln Championships will all be on grass. The SWWRC Championships are held on a surface.

Area Entries: Area entries will be via www.equoEvents.co.uk. Please state your Riding Club in the 'notes' section of your entry, and whether you are in a team or an individual. (*Team Managers – Teams and individuals must be confirmed by Tuesday 1st July. Please do not send in too early to keep changes to a minimum*).

Entries Close at Midnight 29th June 2025: Late entries will only be accepted if numbers allow. The organiser reserves the right to close entries early if necessary.

Preliminary Entries: These must be made to British Riding Clubs Office by Friday 13th June 2025 (21 days before this competition) online via <https://brc.bhs.org.uk/login>

Times: Will be posted on www.ridingclubresults.co.uk on Thursday 3rd July after 8pm.

Withdrawals: These will be refunded via EquoEvents, incurring a £5.00 admin fee to cover the costs incurred with Equo and Stripe, providing they are received before the closing date. You will not be refunded the fee Equo charge for each transaction.

Substitutions: In the event of withdrawals after the closing date, substitutions will be allowed up until 2pm on Friday 4th July. Please **EMAIL** all changes to westdorsetrc@outlook.com

Last minute simple substitutions may be made at the time teams are declared. Simple substitutions are ones where another horse and/or rider replaces the withdrawn one in the same team and position.

SWWRC - South Wales & West of England Riding Club Championships: This is taking place at Hartpury on Saturday 23rd August 2025. This is a Championships for teams from BRC clubs in Areas 9, 12, 15, 18 and 19 competing in Prelim Dressage classes.

Insurance - All Riding Club Members are covered by third party insurance. Anyone attending the event that is **NOT** a riding club member should have their own Third Party Liability Insurance. WD&D Riding Club strongly recommends that all Riding Club Members hold their own Personal Accident insurance in addition to the insurance cover provided by their BRC membership.

RULES

This competition will be run in accordance with the Riding Club Rules for Competitions 2025, with the additional **Area 12 Rule:** A horse may not ride the same course, or the same dressage test with same judge, more than once per day; be competitively ridden by more than two people per day; or have more than four ridden competition efforts per day.

Entry is open to all members of affiliated Riding Clubs in Area 12. Only competitors are permitted to ride horses on the showground.

The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate, split or amend classes as required. Classes may be run in different order to the schedule.

The Judge's decision is final.

Any objections must be handed to the Official Steward no later than 30 minutes after the incident, 30 minutes after the results have been published, or in the case of a protest against qualification of horse/rider, 60 minutes after the start of the class. They must be lodged in writing, with a £20 deposit as per the BRC handbook.

British Riding Clubs, Chard Equestrian Centre and persons acting on their behalf, do not accept any liability for any loss, accident, or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or goods occurring in connection with this event. It is a condition of entry that each competitor indemnifies the organisers against any claim.

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website. If you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518. **Team Managers are responsible for checking this.** As of 1 October 2020, it is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure the horse is chipped and it is traceable.

Rider/bridle numbers must be **displayed on both sides of the horse at all times. If no bridle number, please print and provide your own numbers/bibs. If you do not do this, you will get penalties.**

All hats must have a visible **PINK** BRC/BE/PC hat tag in place before they are worn on the showground, to show that they meet the current safety standards. For up-to-date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook. Hats will be checked and tagged at this competition. Please allow extra time for this process.

Competitors must report to the steward and be ready to ride their test at least 10 minutes before their allotted time.

HEALTH AND SAFETY - The organisers and landowners have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must obey the instructions of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards and take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring. First Aid cover will be provided.

Horses or ponies should not be left tied up outside horseboxes or trailers or left unattended.

All dogs must be on leads, and under control at all times.
