Combined Training consists of one dressage test and one course of show jumps.

The Combined Training Championships is open to both individuals and teams, with all classes mixed juniors and seniors. To be held 26th.-27th September 2026 at Washbrook Farm, Aston-le-Walls, Daventry, Northamptonshire, NN11 6RT,

Times will be available on 10th July 2026 from 7pm.

Team options are:

- Novice Combined Training:
 - 2 team members ride Prelim level dressage tests & 60cm SJ
 - 1 team member rides a Prelim level dressage test & 70cm SJ
 - 1 team member rides a Novice level dressage test & 70cm SJ
- Open Combined Training:
 - 1 team member rides a Prelim level dressage test & 80cm SJ
 - 1 team member rides a Novice level dressage test & 80cm SJ
 - 1 team member rides a Prelim level dressage test & 90cm SJ
 - 1 team member rides a Novice level dressage test & 90cm SJ

Teams can be mix of seniors and juniors. Elimination from one phase will result in elimination from the other. The winning team will be decided from the best three scores in both phases. For eligibility requirements and dressage tests, please visit the 2026 BRC Handbook.

Classes 1,2 and 3 jumping rounds can be part qualifiers for the BRC Club Show Jumping Series. This series is open to non-members to take part in the club shows but to compete at the Final competitors must have a valid club membership.

Entries via Equo - £29 per class. Please indicate team/club name in notes on entry. Rosettes to 6th Place.

This competition will be run under BRC rules. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition.

- Entries in Q classes must have purchased a competition pass from Sport 80 prior to the event.
- Horses may only compete at two consecutive heights, or twice at the same height, provided they are different tests.
- Horse and rider combinations may compete in more than one team in the same class (i.e 2 teams in the Novice CT).
- Passports will be checked on arrival BEFORE unloading. It is the team managers responsibility to check flu vaccination record for their competing club members.
- A designated First Aider will be on site.
- Numbers must be clearly visible - Bibs for SJ and bridle/saddle pad numbers are permitted for Dressage.
- Please park where instructed by stewards and be considerate of others when loading/unloading.
- No horses are to be left unattended when tied to the box.
- All accidents and near misses must be reported to a TDRC steward.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead and under control at all times.
- Please be respectful of the venue and remove all hay and droppings from around the horse boxes when leaving.
- Horse riding is a dangerous sport, and you participate at your own risk, and without any reliance on Taunton & District Riding Club, Area 12 or Stockland Lovell EC for the safety of yourself or property. Due care has been taken to maintain facilities in a safe condition, but riders must observe terms and conditions.
- The judge's decision is final. At all times, all competitors and other visitors must adhere to instructions provided by the stewards.
- Refund Policy: No refunds after closing date. Before closing date refunds less a 25% admin fee.
