Anyone attending the event that is NOT a riding club member should have their own third-party liability insurance and it is recommended that Riding Club Members hold their own Personal Accident insurance in addition to the insurance cover provided by their BRC membership.

Rules and Conditions of Entry:

IT IS THE RIDER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE THEY MEET THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA; THE ELIGIBILITY TABLE CAN BE FOUND IN THE BRC HANDBOOK.

This competition will be run in accordance with the Riding Club Rules for Competitions 2026, with the additional Area 12 Rule: A horse may not ride the same course, or the same dressage test with same judge more than once per day; be competitively ridden by more than two people per day; or have more than four ridden competition efforts per day.

Entry is open to all members of affiliated Riding Clubs in Area 12. Only competitors are permitted to ride horses on the showground.

Horses can only compete in two consecutive classes (ie, Prelim & Novice 0 points, or Novice with Points and Elementary).

Horses may compete in more than 1 team per class, as long as they compete in different tests (ie Team A Prelim 1 and Team B Prelim 2 etc).

All horses/ponies attending this competition must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with G7 in the current BRC Handbook. There is also a downloadable flu vac checking spreadsheet

available to check the flu vaccination. **All passports will be checked on arrival. Please bring to the secretary's cabin.**

Rider/bridle numbers must be displayed on both sides of the horse at all times either on bridle, saddle cloth or printed and used in your own number bib.

Number of riders will be limited in the warm up, on entry to the warm up arena please report to the steward.

The judge's decision in relation to the competition results and that of the Official Steward in relation to all other matters will be final. Any objections must be handed to the Official Steward no later than 30 minutes after the incident, 30 minutes after the results have been published, or in the case of a protest against qualification of horse/rider, 60 minutes after the start of the class. They must be lodged in writing, with a £20 deposit as per the BRC Handbook.

Dressage tests at Area Qualifiers may be commanded.

Withdrawals - these will be refunded via EquoEvents, incurring a £5 admin fee to cover the costs incurred with Equo and Stripe, providing they are received before the 24th October. You will not be refunded the fee Equo charge for each transaction.

Balloting may take place if excessive entries. Qualifying team entries (those who hold competition passes) will be prioritised.

All horses and ponies must be 4 years or older.

All dogs must be on leads and under control at all times.

Please do not skip lorries/trailers out onto the car park – please pick up all droppings and clear up any hay/haylage. No horses/ponies to be left tied up outside to trailers or lorries unattended.

Competitors must wear the correct hats, dress and footwear. Please refer to the BRC rule book 2026. Hats must have a valid and visible **PINK** BRC/BE/PC official hat tag.

Health and Safety - The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards. Owners and riders enter at their own risk.

Legal Liability - Horse/pony sports can be dangerous and animals are unpredictable. Neither the Warman family, Kings Sedgemoor Equestrian, Lamberts Castle Riding Club Ltd or any person acting on their behalf, or the landowners can accept any liability for the loss, damage, accident or injury to any person or property. It is a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the above persons against any legal action arising from such an incident.
